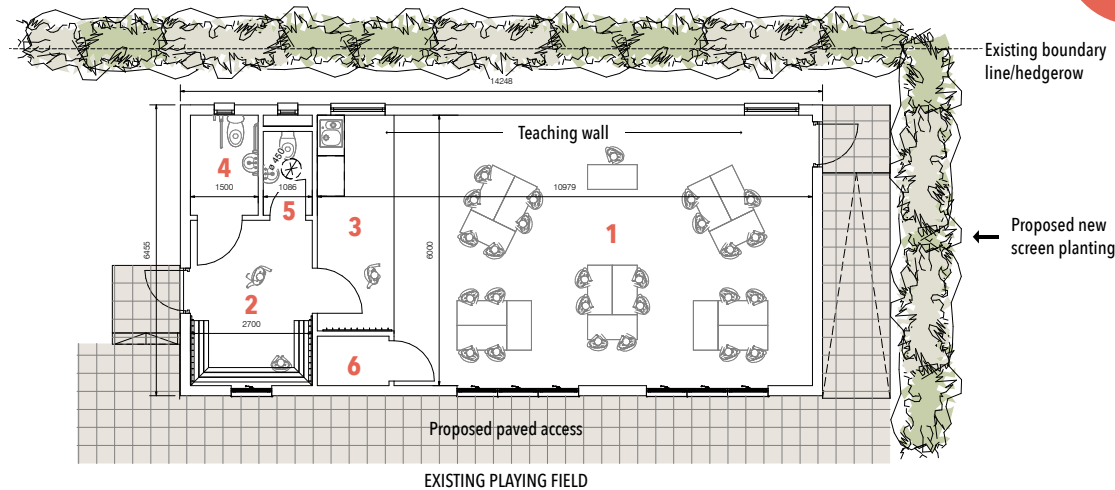

A new housing estate in the village brought rising roll numbers and an urgent need for more classroom space at Sutton Benger Primary School, near Chippenham. The school's leadership team knew they needed a more permanent solution than that offered by a mobile classroom.

After concluding that the school itself, while fairly modern, didn't lend itself to an extension, the school's Finance Officer, Traci Langford, approached Scotts of Thrapston. Working together, Scotts provided Sutton Benger Primary with a turnkey solution.

After Scotts successfully obtained planning permission and building regulations approval, work began towards the end of the summer term. The children were able to see the new building take shape, and took an interest in the construction of their new building.

As a great deal of the building was prepared offsite in Scotts of Thrapston's factory, it made the construction quicker and safer whilst the school was in operation.

The classroom, completed in a matter of weeks, was ready for the Year Six class to move in to when they returned in September. Mrs Langford was impressed with the professionalism and workmanship of the Scotts installation team. The Governors expectations were also exceeded, especially by the high quality internal space conducive to positive learning.
