Made in Britain

All of Scotts windows are manufactured in a purpose-built factory in Northamptonshire. They are produced to meet your specification and to comply with Approved Document Q standards, if required. Scotts can handle a wide variety of window requirements, using a range of hardwoods and softwoods from sustainable sources. Glazing configurations and ironmongery are all individually chosen for each window.







Casement windows

Scotts casement windows offer excellent standards of security and insulation combined with an array of authentic period features. The casement windows incorporate slender glazing bars, if required, and can be manufactured to virtually any specification.

Traditional casement

This robust, flush fitting casement window, of hardwood or softwood construction, is fitted with butt hinges, a traditional cockspur latch and a casement stay to produce a classic window. All manner of glazing patterns can be accommodated, along with a choice of ironmongery finishes, to ensure that the window can blend in with surrounding architecture or to match existing windows.

Flush casement window with flying mullions

A clear and uninterrupted view is exactly what this window offers, with its specially designed arrangement of a pair of side-opening sashes without a central mullion. Modern multipoint locking systems offer high security and either stainless steel friction hinges or classic brass butt hinges afford a simple operating action.

Top hung and hopper hung

Using purpose designed ironmongery, most casement sashes can be hinged from the top or bottom where necessary. Elevated windows are supplied with extended poles and hooks for easy opening and closing.

Easy clean

In order to facilitate easy cleaning on both sides, this window has hinges that open to a full 90° on an offset pivot. Stainless steel friction hinges and a concealed multi-point locking system give this window a smooth and simple operating action with the added comfort of high security.







Sliding sash windows

Ingenious and practical, the sliding sash window is a much loved and prominent feature of period buildings across the country. Using traditional skills and high performance materials, Scotts sliding sash windows are made in several styles making them ideal for use in new build projects or as replacements for existing dilapidated windows.

Classic design

The classic sliding sash window is the ideal solution for listed buildings. This traditional design sash window offers a faithful replica of the original for today's building environment and incorporates slender glazing bars, rails and ironmongery with various finishes. Traditional weights and pulleys offer an exceptionally smooth operation on even the largest sliding sash window installations.

Slim-Box

The slim-box design of sash window is ideal for properties without a window reveal. Similar in design to the classic sliding sash window, this style utilises spiral balances instead of the weights and pulleys, so reducing the overall box width by 50mm. The exterior appearance is identical to the traditional deep box sliding sash window.

Slide and tilt

Designed to simplify cleaning, the slide and tilt window has the advantage of two tilting sashes. Discreet locking systems preserve the overall elegance of the window and maintain the period feel. This window is ideal for elevated locations where easy cleaning or emergency access is an important issue.

Yorkshire slider

Opening horizontally rather than vertically, the "Yorkshire Slider" is a traditional feature of some older, country properties. It has all the advantages of Scotts classic sash windows and the running gear provides a clean and positive action.







French doors

French doors from Scotts of Thrapston add an elegant look to your property and allow light to flood in through the full height glazing. Manufactured from hardwood, to maintain structural integrity, they are supplied with high security, multipoint locking systems and provide the ultimate in durability and longevity.
